Asheville area tourism partners are ringing in the new year with strong gains in January visitation. Results for the full month aren't in just yet, but the 28-day period ending January 23, posted a 9.6 percent increase in hotel occupancy to reach 63.1 percent (compared to 31.6% for January 15 years ago!).

Makers of WNC and the CVB's PR team have worked together to generate national media coverage of Asheville's craft scene. In the PBS digital program "[Original Fare](#)," Kelly Cox produced a great episode on some of Asheville's strongest talent, focusing on "women makers." And the American Craft Council featured Asheville as a "mecca for craft connoisseurs" in the February/March issue of [American Craft](#). Thank you to our partners who contributed to these thoughtful pieces.

### PR Team Shares 2016 News During Winter Media Tours



Biltmore will be recognized at the National Tour Association's (NTA) annual convention, January 31-February 4 in Atlanta. ## 2016 Cyclo-cross Nationals "Best Ever"

The 2016 USA Cycling Cyclo-cross National Championship held at Biltmore earlier this month was a huge success! Booked back in 2012 through a joint effort of the ACVB and Asheville Buncombe Regional Sports Commission, the event was the contributing factor in the increase in occupancy for the period of January 3-9. Occupancy was up 25% for the week over 2015 and up 37% over 2015 for the weekend. Congratulations to the local organizing committee and all the volunteers involved that helped make this great event happen.

The Nationals attracted close to 2,000 participants and many more spectators and fans. The ACVB staffed an area booth throughout the event, using the opportunity to acquaint participants with Asheville as many were first-time



visitors. ABRSC's Program Director, Micah Pulley, shared, "Just about everywhere you read about CX Nats, you see that people are calling this the "best ever"... from the venue to the volunteers, spectator support, course, and expo. Asheville is indeed in the spotlight right now, and cyclists are begging to come back." This is collaboration at its best. The ACVB will continue to partner with ABRSC to identify and bring events of this caliber to Asheville.
