Effective Immediately: Restrictions Lifted on Lodging

Official Buncombe Announcement Today 2pm

Attention Lodging Partners:

Last night in a special board meeting, the Buncombe County Commissioners voted unanimously to lift local restrictions that limited hotels and other short-term lodging facilities to 50% capacity, effective immediately and in alignment with Governor Roy Cooper's orders for the State of North Carolina.

Economic data provided by the Asheville Buncombe Hotel Association, the Asheville Bed & Breakfast Association, and the Asheville Homestay Network, undoubtedly informed this decision.
