The Buncombe County Tourism Development Authority's Legacy Investment from Tourism (LIFT) Fund provides financial investment through grants, loan guarantees, or pledges of debt service to tourism-related capital projects that will increase patronage of lodging facilities and benefit the community at large in Buncombe County. In the first cycle of the LIFT Fund, the Buncombe County Tourism Development Authority (BCTDA) invested **nearly \$10 million in 12 community projects across Buncombe County**.
