TOURISM PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT FUND (TPDF) INVESTMENT SUMMARY

The Tourism Product Development Fund comes from one-third of the occupancy tax paid by visitors who stay overnight in Buncombe County in commercial lodging facilities including hotels, vacation rentals, and bed and breakfast inns. Since the fund's inception, the Buncombe County Tourism Development Authority has provided nearly **\$86 million through 64 investments in 41 community projects across Buncombe County**. Many of these projects would not have been possible without it.

The TPDF has funded several major tourism capital projects, including:

- **\$45 million** for all City of Asheville-owned and applied projects
- **\$7.1 million** for the City of Asheville's Riverfront Redevelopment project
- **\$7.2 million** for the Harrah's Cherokee Center – Asheville
- **\$23.95 million** for the City of Asheville's McCormick Field
- **\$18.9 million** for all Buncombe County-owned and applied projects
- **\$8.14 million** for the Town of Woodfin's Blueway & Greenway
- **\$10.8 million** for the Buncombe County Sports Park
- **\$2.5 million** for Pack Square Park

*** The City of Asheville was originally awarded a total of \$1.7 million in the 2015 cycle. The city withdrew the Beaucatcher Greenway from the scope reducing the award by \$975,000.

SPECIAL NOTE: Buncombe County Tourism Jobs Recovery Fund

To help local businesses begin to recover from the pandemic and save jobs, legislation signed into law in May 2020 by Gov. Roy Cooper allowed the Buncombe County TDA to appropriate \$5 million from unallocated monies in the Tourism Product Development Fund to establish a one-time emergency relief grant program. By the end of June 2020, a total of 394 local small businesses and nonprofits that provide a direct visitor experience were awarded grants of up to \$50,000 through the Buncombe County Tourism Jobs Recovery Fund to help safely restart businesses and support nearly 4,800 jobs. One year later, 97% of grantees were still in operation.
